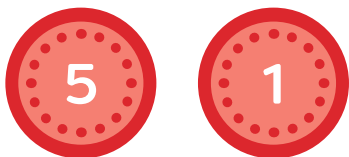
Read along with The Library this summer during the Summer Reading Challenge.
